If you have visited CME California in the past, **login with your email and password**. If not, click **Create an Account** to do so.

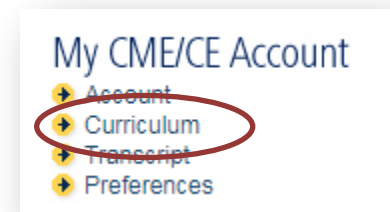

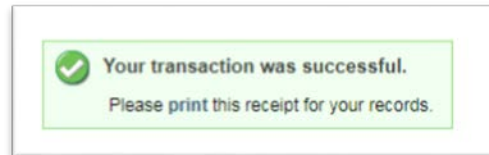

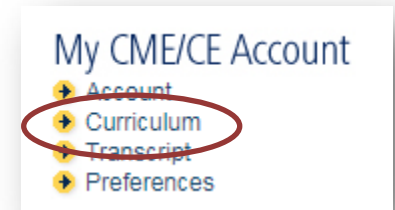
